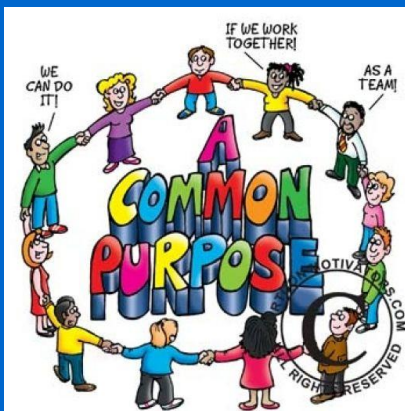

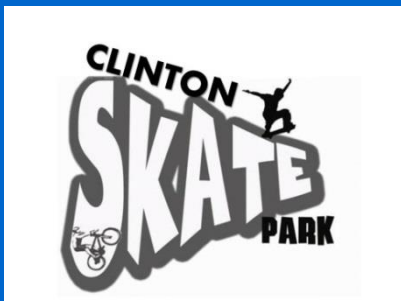

6. Leadline pleasure (walk only) – 7 & under
7. Leadline walk/jog/trot – 7 & under

TACK HOLD – 5 MIN or less

8. Leadline costume (walk only) – 7 & under
9. Walk/jog/trot pleasure – 13 & under (may not enter any canter or lope classes with same horse)
10. Walk/jog/trot equitation no pattern – 13 & under (may not enter any canter or lope classes with same horse)
11. Walk/jog/trot equitation no pattern – 14-18
12. Open walk/jog/trot pleasure (may not enter any canter or lope classes with same horse)
13. Open junior horse (5 & under) + maiden horse pleasure (1<sup>st</sup> year showing under saddle anywhere)

TACK HOLD – 5 MIN or less

14. Open costume walk/jog/trot (individual class or points split between participants)
15. Senior English pleasure – 19+
16. Junior English pleasure – 14-18
17. Junior English pleasure – 13 & under
- 18. Trail class with jump – English or Western \*will be first class after lunch\***
19. Senior English equitation with pattern – 19+
20. Junior English equitation with pattern – 14-18
21. Junior English equitation with pattern – 13 & under
22. Open Arabian English pleasure
23. Open Show Hack with 10 required gaits
24. Jack Benny – 35+
25. Open Arabian Native costume – walk/canter/hand gallop
26. Open Western pleasure
27. Open Arabian Western pleasure
