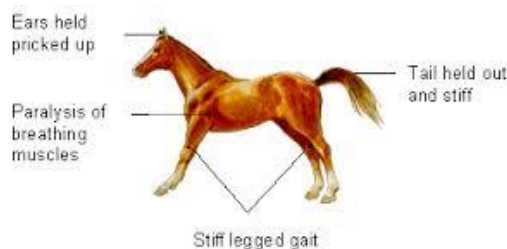

VACCINES (new vaccine information each month)



Tetanus

Tetanus is caused by a hardy bacteria found in the soil. It thrives in areas with little oxygen such as deep within tissue wounds; foot wounds being a key source. Once infected, it can take one to three weeks for clinical signs to present

which means that often wounds have healed before we see symptoms. Affected horses display a frightened expression because of facial spasms, nostrils flare, their ears are held back and they have a wide-eyed appearance. They have difficulty chewing and opening their mouth. Often their tail is held up and out. Affected horses walk stiffly ("like a board") without bending their neck. The muscles of the jaw "seize up" and the horse is unable to eat; commonly known as "lock jaw". Eventually, horses are unable to stand. Their respiratory muscles become affected and so they have difficulty breathing resulting in death. (AAEP guidelines suggest vaccinating annually)

Vaccinations/Dental checks:

Have you spoken with your Veterinarian to ensure your horse is healthy and protected for the 2015 year?
